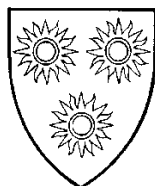

POPE FRANCIS: To mark the fifth anniversary of his election this year a series of lectures has been organised by the Diocese to allow us to look back, to assess, and to think ahead. The lectures take place at St John's Church, South Parade, Bath, and begin at 7pm and the next in the series is on Tuesday 25 September by Fr James Hanvey SJ "Pope Francis and the future"! Fr James Hanvey SJ is Master of Campion Hall in Oxford, accompanied our diocesan pilgrimage to the Holy Land and Assisi, and facilitated a week of study in 2017 for some of our priests. He has been a Headmaster, lecturer at Heythrop, and theological consultant for the Bishops' Conference. The lectures are free and all are welcome.
