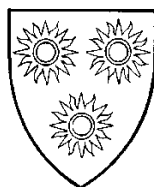

The obligation to attend Mass remains suspended and parishioners should not attend if they show symptoms of COVID-19, are self-isolating, or shielding. For those parishioners who attend Mass, **face coverings are now mandatory unless you have a legitimate reason for not wearing one.** The church will be open for half an hour before all Masses for those who wish to pray privately. Do not socialise with members of other households in the church or in the porch after Mass. If the person in the bench in front of you is sitting, please either sit or stand and do not kneel behind them. It is perfectly acceptable to sit, if necessary, during the Eucharistic Prayer. Leave the church promptly at the end of Mass since the volunteer cleaners need to clean the church. For the reception of Holy Communion, keep your face covering in place as you approach Father Vincent. With arms fully extended and with palms upwards receive the host in the hand, then take a step to either the left or the right, unloop the face covering and consume the host. Then replace your face covering and return to your place via a side aisle. Do not return to your place until you have consumed the host and replaced your face covering. Parishioners are asked to pre-book a place for each Mass they plan to attend by email or telephone to Christine Martin at [calnemail@btinternet.com](mailto:calnemail@btinternet.com) or 01249 814086. For Saturday/Sunday Mass, contact Christine by Friday evening stating which Mass you would like to attend and how many people will be attending. You will be allocated specific seats in the church for that Mass. For Thursday Mass, contact Christine by Tuesday evening. Thank you all for your patience with these matters and to our volunteer stewards and cleaners for their service to our parish.

**NHS COVID-19 APP** is now available. If you are using this App the unique QR code for the church is now on display on the windows by the main doors. By using the NHS Covid-19 App you can use your smartphone to scan this QR code to record that you have visited the church.

**THIS WEEKEND** there will be a retiring collection for Peter's Pence, postponed from 28/29 June, a worldwide collection that supports the activities of the Holy See through which Pope Francis governs the Church and exercises his charitable works.

**PARISH PROJECT:** We have sent cheques for £435.65 to the charity, TREE AID. This money was raised with the New Year raffle, Lent soup lunches and the Lenten Challenge to eat simply. TREE AID was established in 1987 following the famine in Ethiopia. It supports some of the poorest people to lift themselves out of poverty by planting trees and restoring degraded land. The trees are a lifeline providing nutritious fruit, nuts, seeds and leaves and the local people are empowered to grow, protect and use trees to feed their families.
