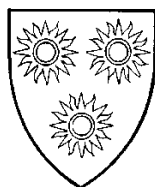

The obligation to attend Mass remains suspended. Parishioners should not attend Church if they show symptoms of COVID-19, are self-isolating, or shielding. Face coverings are mandatory for those attending Mass, unless you have a legitimate reason for not wearing one. Do not socialise with members of other households in the church or in the porch after Mass. Do not kneel directly behind another parishioner. It is perfectly acceptable to sit, if necessary, during the Eucharistic Prayer. Leave the church promptly at the end of Mass since the volunteer cleaners need to clean the church. MARCH 28th – PALM SUNDAY of the PASSION OF THE LORD

Entrance Antiphon: Hosanna to the Son of David, the king of Israel. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

First Reading: Is 50: 4-7

Psalm Response: My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

Second Reading: Phil 2: 6-11

Gospel Acclamation: Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory!

Christ was humbler yet,
even to accepting death, death on a cross.

But God raised him high
and gave him the name which is above all names.
Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory!

Gospel Reading: Mark 15: 1-39

Communion Antiphon: Father, if this cup may not last, but I must drink it, then your will be done.

1st APRIL - HOLY THURSDAY

Entrance Antiphon: It is our duty to glory in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ. He saves us and sets us free; through him we find salvation, life and resurrection.

First Reading: Ex 12: 1-8, 11-14

Psalm Response: The blessing-cup that we bless is a communion with the blood of Christ.

Second Reading: 1Cor 11: 23 -26

Gospel Acclamation: Praise and honour to you Lord Jesus! I give you a new commandment: love one another just as I have loved you, says the Lord. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!

Gospel Reading: John 13: 1-15

Communion Antiphon: This body will be given for you. This is the cup of the new covenant in my blood; whenever you receive them do so in remembrance of me.

Psalm Response: Father, into your hands I commend my spirit.

Second Reading: Heb 4: 14-16, 5: 7-9

Gospel Acclamation: Glory and praise to you, O Christ!
